

#### **Tour Poster**









This image was created using photoshop. The butterflies in the image were created with commercial use brushes. The technique I used in this image was to put an oil filter on the skin, but leaving the eyes and mouth natural. I then painted in my dark and light shadows using curves. I also smoothed out certain parts of the skin. The final product is meant to give the feel of hyper real painting.

We used an old lantern that I later filled with light and a smaller image of the model as a fairy. The butterflies were created with commercial use brushes. I used a stock image for the sparks.

## Knowledge


